Teaching teams and families partnered together, using their resources to engage children remotely in lessons and continue learning and interacting with one another. There were lessons on plants using video from a teacher's garden, educational packets mailed out, mindfulness videos, lessons on art from a teacher playing the role of an art critic, stories read remotely, virtual group meet ups and more!

The Children's Services teams made sure everyone stayed connected. One student, Mason wanted a way to show his teachers that he got their messages and that he could not wait to see them again. His family took Mason to SPIN Parkwood for a picture to send out with a loving message to his SPIN family!



Determination Seals the Job for Kevin

The road to employment often includes twists and turns. Kevin's job search took an unexpected turn as COVID changed our lives and the job market. Motivation to find employment in the midst of a pandemic can feel impossible, but not for Kevin! When SPIN's job development support shifted to virtual, Kevin's determination to achieve his employment goals never wavered. With the support of Employment Specialist, Akeem, Kevin began applying for positions in industries that needed people most, especially grocery stores. Kevin and Akeem diligently researched open positions, prepared for virtual interviews, and finally, Kevin landed a job at BJ's! He's now working 4 days a week, operating a forklift, and making sure the parking lot at BJ's is always well-maintained. He is enjoying working outside and serving the BJ's customers. Kevin's confidence is off the charts and his story shows that even in unprecedented times, with determination and support, the right job is just around the corner!

Arik

When Arik was first diagnosed with Autism at 18 months, his parents worried that his struggles communicating, tolerating foods, and progressing with self-care would limit his life. Doctors told Arik's parents he would likely never speak. Arik and his SPIN Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Team, had a different plan. Arik began speaking at age 14 and is now eating more types of food than his family ever dreamed. His Dad told us, "It's just amazing! I never thought I would see my son eating these foods and talking like he does now." In the recent months of telehealth sessions alone, Arik's Behavioral Health Technician, Joel and his Behavior Support Counselor, Aubrey, have helped Arik master buttoning his shirt and wearing a mask, both huge accomplishments. "Arik, his family, and his story give my career a purpose." noted Aubrey. Arik gained important skills necessary for expanding his world through ABA and the possibilities are endless!





SPIN's Growth and Value of Fifty Years

Only seven people stayed after the official meeting of the Home & School Association one evening in early 1970; six parents of children with 'special needs' and one teacher. Their dream was a summer camp. Each pitched in \$5 for a starting budget. They named their dream "Camp SPIN", but the price of insurance became the obstacle to opening that first summer.

Disappointed, but undeterred, they pushed on holding almost weekly grassroots fundraising efforts. Fifteen months after the dream began, Camp SPIN opened. Filled with fun, love, hope, connection, and people who believed that everyone is valuable and flourishes with the right support. This became the legacy of SPIN.

Through fifty years of learning and growing, SPIN thrives today because of a strong foundation, a powerful belief in values and the love and devotion of families, staff, and community. SPIN has nurtured, supported and enabled *a life of possibilities* for thousands of people and families over these fifty years.

Disappointments and setbacks will always be part of the landscape for SPIN, but we have learned well from our Founders. Our belief in people and one another is powerful and our resolve is unwavering.
