# RELATIONSHIPS THROUGH COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS

Over the past year, SPIN Community Participation Supports (CPS) has served over 150 people in virtual services in Philadelphia and the Lehigh Valley. Virtual activities such as music, art, games, and educational classes encourage socialization, connection, and engagement. We also reopened in-person services in June and reconnected with our community through volunteering.

In Philadelphia, we have volunteered with the Jewish Relief Agency. We pack boxes filled with necessities for the elderly and deliver them to their homes. We also virtually created greeting cards to bring joy to those who need it most.

In Lehigh, we partner with Meals on Wheels of the Greater Lehigh Valley. They can rely on the 22 resilient SPIN volunteers that follow all health and safety precautions, ensuring meals are delivered safely and with a smile. Relationships blossom while actively helping those around us!
